Recital Night Information

Monday, June 4th, 2018

Show starts at 6:30 p.m.

Please arrive at the Centennial Concert Hall **no earlier** than 5:30pm in full costume, hair and make-up; enter through the backstage door near the parkade entrance on Lily Street. We ask that only **ONE PARENT/GUARDIAN** bring your child backstage and to their designated dressing room in order to keep the crowd to a minimum.

You will meet your class chaperone(s) in your assigned dressing room to check in and make any pick up arrangements with them for intermission or at the end of the show.

PLEASE NOTE: Dancers in the first half of the show only, must be picked up at intermission; dancers in the second half will stay with their volunteer until the end of the show (or be switched between volunteers at intermission, if they have multiple routines).

You must give the volunteer the name of the **ONE PERSON** who will be picking up your child on recital night. This person cannot change and if the volunteer doesn't know them, they may ask for ID. The 'pick up spot' will be in your assigned dressing room so that the hallways will stay clear of congestion. We will arrange for a meet the volunteer date in class prior to Recital.

Our “prenale” includes all students taking the stage for a bow before the first number. The DBSD staff will also be introduced while the students are onstage. To make this run smoothly it is important that you arrive and be in your dressing room **before 6pm** so that we can start to arrange students in line shortly after.

After the “prenale” the students will leave the stage as a class to meet up with their chaperone(s). They will either go up to the second balcony to watch or line up backstage for their turn in the spotlight!

Volunteers for young children ages 3-5 you may choose to keep children in the dressing room or rehearsal hall with activities.
